## **REVIEW**

The dense paint Alejandro Tosco: a dialogue between art and nature The density of this painting is, at the same time, visual and tactile, rational and sensitive. represents an approach to reality through the senses, but without discarding the rational analysis and the poetic interpretation. It is the culmination of a process involving vision and experience, knowledge and sensitive interpretation. The result is the re-creation of a world that is shown through different sensory properties, more visually striking and contained than in its natural state, more complex and full of meaning following a journey through the artist's core.

#### A creative subject: Alejandro Tosco

It treats of an abstract work with a strong figurative reminiscence derivatives of the perception of the subaquatic world. The symbolic element burst into strongly. This is the symbolic plane that we find in Alejandro Tosco's painting. We see as well as the chain of the pictorial Canary tradition re-lives in Alejandro Tosco's work, at least in one of the lines of the same one, the one that thinks not only about the volcanic landscapes of the archipelago, but also on the relation of his inhabitants with the sea that bathes his coasts. It takes me pleasure to know that the links of this tradition are not few. Of this chain we only know one of his ends, which is deeply taken root in the images of the insular nature.
